

## Arrests Made in Methamphetamine Distribution Investigation

### Updated Press Release | March 7, 2017

In September 2014, the Northern Colorado Drug Task Force concluded a long-term investigation into the distribution of methamphetamine from 2816 E. Vine Street in Fort Collins. During the course of the investigation, 12 pounds of methamphetamine were seized. Nine individuals were arrested, ranging from local distributors to U.S.-based individuals tied to sources of supply in Sinaloa, Mexico.

The following individuals have now been convicted at jury trial of felony crimes associated with the distribution of methamphetamine and/or violations of the Colorado Organized Crime Control Act. All three were determined to also be habitual criminals due to lengthy felony criminal histories and sentenced to the Colorado Department of Corrections for the following terms:

- Gerald Moore (01/05/64) – 96 years
- Darrick Heimann (12/15/67) – 64 years
- Darren Heimann (12/15/67) – 48 years

No additional information will be released at this time.

### Original Press Release

On September 26, 2014 the Northern Colorado Drug Task Force served five search warrants as part of a long-term investigation into methamphetamine distribution in Larimer County. The warrants were served in Fort Collins, Longmont, Lakewood, and Arvada.

The initial service of the warrants was facilitated with the participation of SWAT teams from Fort Collins Police Services, Larimer County, Weld County, and Jefferson County. They were assisted the Criminal Impacts Unit from Fort Collins Police, the Fort Collins Police Services Neighborhood Enforcement Team, Department of Correction – Parole Division, and detectives from Loveland Police Department and West Metro Drug Task Force. In the course of the investigation, over 12 pounds of methamphetamine, more than \$8,800 in U.S. Currency, cocaine, prescription pills, and one firearm were seized.

Five subjects were arrested on various charges. Those arrested were:

- Richard Maddox (04/24/60)
- Gerald Moore (01/05/64)
- Darrick Heimann (12/15/67)
- Darren Heimann (12/15/67)

The Northern Colorado Drug Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional team staffed by personnel from the Loveland Police Department, Colorado Adult Parole, and Fort Collins Police Services.
