On December 10, 2013 the Northern Colorado Drug Task Force (NCDTF) served a search warrant at 3522 Preakness Way in Wellington, Colorado.

NCDTF detectives received information from investigators in Springfield, Illinois that the home's resident had been arrested for facilitating the transportation of over 60 pounds of marijuana from Colorado. The NCDTF, with the assistance of the Larimer County Sheriff's Office-Criminal Impact Unit, served the warrant to support the Springfield investigation.

When law enforcement officers entered the home, they discovered marijuana, firearms, and a large amount of apparent explosive devices/material. The Northern Colorado Bomb Squad and agents of the Bureau of Alcohol, Tobacco, Firearms, and Explosives (ATF) responded to assist. Several items were seized as evidence and agents of the ATF will pursue charges through the United States Attorney's Office. The NCDTF then completed its original search warrant. There is no current danger to citizens.

No booking photos or additional information are available to the NCDTF at this time and no further details will be released by this office.

The Northern Colorado Drug Task Force is a multi-jurisdictional team staffed by personnel from Fort Collins Police Services, the Loveland Police Department, and Colorado Adult Parole.
